Do You Feel All Alone? Don't Stay In This Sad Place!

God created mankind and all things. He individually loves you and wants to be your God; then, you won't be alone. He spoke the world into existence and desires man to have dominion over all His works. This is the great love of a Father for his children! Take a moment to think about this.

"I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded...". (Isaiah 45:12)

"And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion...". (Gen.1:26)

Creation itself bears witness of Him! Our loving God desires that you have a faith response, as did the Thessalonians.

"For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen...". (Romans 1:20)

"...how ye (Thessalonians) turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, And to wait for his Son from heaven...". (I Thessalonians 1:9-10)

Believe God and His Word! When He says something, it is always true and right. He never lies. God knows you individually... every person. The Scripture teaches that His desire is for an eternal, Father-son relationship. Though no one is perfect, yet His love is immeasurable unto all!

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)



God is righteous and holy so He must judge sin. There is a price that needs to be paid for sin; but you can trust God.

"In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel." (Romans 2:16)

The good news is that God loved you so much **He paid your price**; His Son died and rose from the dead. Jesus Christ's blood paid for all your sin so you can live forever with Him in heaven. This is the gospel of Christ.

"Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus." (Romans 3:24)

All you do is believe the Truth, then God gives you His perfect righteousness so you can have peace with Him. Sin is totally paid for by Christ's death on the cross. It is not determined by your good works, nor maintaining a good life to keep His favor. It is a *free* gift from God.

"Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference." (Romans 3:22)



"Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law." (Romans 3:28)

You have a few things once you believe: justified, peace with God, access by faith into grace, a grace standing before God. Now, you can also rejoice in a wonderful hope. God will always be with you... NEVER ALONE AGAIN!

"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God." (Rom. 5:1-2) To conclude, you inherited sin from Adam and CAN'T be righteous on your own. God sent His Son to pay for all sin because He loves you. Now think, do you believe Him?

"Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation (fully satisfying sacrifice) through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God."

(Romans 3:25)

Simple faith in the work Christ did on the cross sets you free from sin. You no longer need to fear judgment, nor death. You have peace with God; sin has been dealt with.

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

As you choose to walk by faith, God will help you grow. He wants you to mature in your faith by reading the Scripture. Start in the book of Romans. Chapters 1-5 will help you be confident in your new relationship with God and His great love for you. Read it with Job's attitude:

"...I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food." (Job 23:12)

As you read and respond by faith to God's Word, you will realize more about His great love for you. God has provided His Spirit to live inside you; He'll never leave you!

"(God) Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts. (II Corinthians 1:22)
